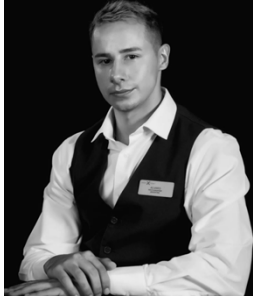

04/2013 Theoretical and Practical Course of Adaptation to the Field

- The Practical was made in the Town of La Cruz, Córdoba - Argentina
- Maneuvers performed:
 - Terrain recognition and possible threats
 - Shelter construction
 - Day and night land navigation
 - Passage of combat track
 - First aid
 - Construction of traps to obtain food
 - Methods of obtaining and purifying water
 - It should be noted that this was not a survival exercise, it was simply the first contact we had against the adversities that the terrain can show. In this exercise I learned to know myself a little more, to interact and work as a team under unfavorable situations.

03/2014 Theoretical and practical course of Mountain survival

- The Practical was made in the Town of Los Gigantes, Córdoba – Argentina
- In this exercise we have the logistical support of the GAM 8, Unit dependent on the Argentine Army and the IV Air Brigade of the Air Force, the theoretical knowledge acquired is put to the test.
- The situation from which the Exercise begins is the assumption of an aircraft crew member who, due to some situation, falls to the ground, having to survive in the particular mountain environment until he can be rescued.
- Maneuvers performed:
 - Construction of a suitable shelter that allows you to shelter from inclement weather
 - Making traps to get food
 - Application of necessary first aid techniques
 - Implementation of systems to obtain and purify water
 - Carrying out signaling techniques so that rescue teams are able to locate them from the air.
 - Carrying out rope activities such as rock climbing, abseiling, zipline, cable car, orientation and mountain walking with a final ascent to the Cerro

- In this seven-five-day maneuver, I learned to overcome the real adversities of the mountain, achieving adequate self-control, promoting interaction with my companions, getting to know my own limitations and virtues.
- During this Exercise we are under the constant supervision of instructors from the Cadet Corps, instructors from the Air Force Training and Survival Center and mountain instructors from the Argentine Army.

09/2014 Theoretical and practical course of Jungle survival

- The Practical was made in the City of Reconquista, specifically on El Tala Island, Santa Fe – Argentina.
- The situation from which the Exercise begins is the assumption of an aircraft crew member who, due to some situation, falls to the ground, having to survive in the particular mountain environment until he can be rescued.
- To carry out this activity, we had the logistical contribution of the III Air Brigade, a unit on which the facilities located on Isla El Tala and the Training and Survival Center depend, in addition to the VII Air Brigade that sends a helicopter in support of the operation.
- Maneuvers performed:
 - Construction of a suitable shelter that allows you to shelter from inclement weather
 - Making traps to get food
 - Application of necessary first aid techniques
 - Implementation of systems to obtain and purify water
 - Carrying out signaling techniques so that rescue teams are able to locate them from the air
 - Orientation exercises through land navigation
 - Combat and first aid check trail
 - River crossing through various methods that include from swimming to the use of ropes
 - During this exercise we were under the constant supervision of instructors from the Cadet Corps and instructors from the Air Force Training and Survival Center.

05/2015 Theoretical and practical course of Desert survival

- The Practical was made in the Town of Lucio V. Mansilla, in the northwest of the province of Córdoba, specifically in the Salinas Grandes.
- The situation from which the Exercise begins is the assumption of an aircraft crew member who, due to some situation, falls to the ground, having to survive in the particular mountain environment until he can be rescued.
- Maneuvers performed:
 - Construction of a suitable shelter that allows you to shelter from inclement weather
 - Making traps to get food
 - Application of necessary first aid techniques
 - Implementation of systems to obtain and purify water
 - Carrying out signaling techniques so that rescue teams are able to locate them from the air
 - Orientation exercises through the execution of land, day and night navigations
 - Personnel recovery exercise using a helicopter provided by the VII Air Brigade

04/2016 Theoretical and practical course of Sea survival

- The Practical was made in the Town of Mar del Plata, Buenos Aires – Argentina.
- To complete the operation, we had the support of the Argentine Navy Tactical Divers Association, who facilitate their facilities and the invaluable contribution of their instructors. There is also a Helicopter from the VII Air Brigade, a C-130 aircraft from the I Air Brigade and logistical support from the Mar del Plata Military Air Base, all of which are units dependent on the Air Force.
- The situation from which the Exercise begins is the assumption of an aircraft crew member who, due to some situation, falls to the sea, having to survive in the particular mountain environment until he can be rescued.
- Maneuvers performed:
 - Once at the headquarters of the group of tactical divers with the neoprene suits in place, we swam to the saved rafts, located and anchored 200 meters from the coast.
 - Procedures of obtaining and purification of water
 - Techniques of obtaining food
 - Maintenance of personal health through the application of first aid
 - Appropriate marking so that aerial rescue teams are able to locate them from the air.
 - Break-away plows with Zodiac inflatable boats
 - Borda jump from ships of the Argentine Navy
 - Hoisted by crane from helicopter
 - Physical activity on the beach
